Skill	Mark
The student is wearing the white coat and introduces him/herself to the patient	
The student identifies the used tool and the tendon of the tested muscle	
The student properly handles the medical hammer and places the tested subject and the tested muscle in the correct position to perform the required jerk	
The student hits the tested muscle tendon with the medical hammer and observes the contraction of the tested muscle	
The student recognizes the pathway of the tested reflex as well as how to reinforce it and causes of increased or decreased response

Skill	Mark
The student is wearing the white coat and introduces him/herself to the patient	
The student identifies the used tool (tuning fork) and its frequency	
The student properly holds the tuning fork from its base and demonstrates how to produce its vibration	
The student demonstrates the right way to perform the required tuning fork test.	
The student can interpret the result of the performed tuning fork test and differentiate between conductive and sensorineural deafness.
