 - 2 of its tributaries ?
 Ophthalmic vein - Central vein of the retina.
 Sphenoparietal sinus - Superior petrosal sinus -
 Inferior petrosal sinus

- Identify this fold ? Tentorium Cerebelli
 - 2 Related sinus ? superior petrosal sinus -
 transverse sinus - straight sinus

- Identify this sinus ? Superior Sagittal Sinus
 - Termination:
 * Usually continues as the right transverse sinus.
 * Sometimes, unites with the straight sinus
 to form confluence of sinuses, which gives
 right and left venous sinuses



- Identify this sinus? Inferior Sagittal Sinus
 - Termination:
 Joins the great cerebral vein to form
 the straight sinus


- Identify this sinus ? transverse sinus
 - Origin :
 * Usually: Right side from the superior sagittal
 sinus, Left side: from the straight sinus
 * Or may come from confluence of sinuses.
 - Termination ? becoming the sigmoid sinus.

- Identify this fold ? Falx Cerebri
 - 2 related sinus ? Superior Sagittal -
 Inferior Sagittal - Straight Sinuses

- Identify this sinus ? straight
 sinus
 - Origin ?
 * Union of Inferior Sagittal
 Sinus & great cerebral vein
 - Termination?
 * Mainly turns to the left
 forming the left
 transverse sinus
 * May open into confluence of
 sinuses

- Identify this fold ? Falx Cerebelli
 - Related sinus ? Occipital sinus





- Identify? Right lobe of thyroid gland
- Extention ?
* Apex : Oblique line of Thyroid Cartilage
* Base : 5th tracheal ring

Pyramidal lobe

- Identify? Left lobe of thyroid gland
- Extention ?
* Apex : Oblique line of Thyroid Cartilage
* Base : 5th tracheal ring

- Identify ? Isthmus
- Tracheal ring of this part ? 2nd-4th tracheal ring

- Superior thyroid vein
- Termination: internal jugular vein

- Middle thyroid vein
- Termination: internal jugular vein

Recurrent laryngeal nerve


- Identify this artery? Superior thyroid artery

- Origin? Thyrocervical trunk from 1st part of subclavian




- Mention 2 structures related to it anteriorly ?
